Publication of Final Preliminary Documentation

Jellinbah Group Pty Ltd proposes the Jellinbah Coal Mine Central North Extension (EPBC 2018/8139). The purpose of the proposed Project is to extend approved mining activities at the Jellinbah Coal Mine further to the east and expand the area available for spoil dumping and topsoil placement. No changes to the currently approved mining methods or production rates are proposed. The proposed action is located approximately 30km north-east of Blackwater, Qld.

The proposed action has been referred under the Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999 (EPBC Act) and determined to be a "controlled action" under the EPBC Act to be assessed on Preliminary Documentation. The controlling provisions under the EPBC Act are:

- Listed threatened species and communities (sections 18 & 18A); and
- A water resource, in relation to coal seam gas development and large coal mining development (sections 24D & 24E)

Public comment was sought from 10 January 2020 to 23 January 2020. No public comments were received during this period, and the period for public comment is now closed.
